

"Eligible Green Projects" includes:

(i) investments related to maintenance, upgrades and energy efficiency of the rail system;

(ii) investments related to new rail lines and rail line extensions; and

(iii) other investments linked to the global climate change challenges, the protection of biodiversity and natural resources.*

*Note: the Issuer expects the majority of the net proceeds to be allocated to the first two categories of Eligible Green Projects set out above. The inclusion of other investments linked to the protection or biodiversity and natural resources is essential to the Issuer's overall environmental and sustainability strategy.
