## SES launches new video distribution neighborhood for Latin America A new antenna seeding program is in progress

The antenna program will be managed by Encompass Digital Media's Latin American operation (formerly TIBA), including procurement, distribution and logistics. The goal is to provide comprehensive reach to all cable head-ends from Mexico to Argentina.
