EDF Energies Nouvelles commissions a 70 MW wind farm in Italy

Pursuing its development in Italy, EDF Energies Nouvelles has announced the commissioning of the Campidano wind farm in Sardinia. With 70 MW in installed capacity, this wind farm is equipped with 35 Vestas V90 wind turbines.

The Campidano facility is held jointly by EDF EN Italia, a 95%-owned subsidiary of EDF Energies Nouvelles, and by Fri-El Green Power, a local partner.

With Campidano, EDF Energies Nouvelles has completed its fourth wind farm in Italy. The Group commissioned 22 MW in capacity in Sardinia during 2004 (Nurri), 70 MW in Campania during 2005 (Andretta Bisaccia) and 72 MW in Puglia during 2007 (Sant'Agata).

To date, EDF Energies Nouvelles owns 234 MW in gross capacity in Italy, including 111.15 MW for its own account.

With operations in nine European countries and in the United States, EDF Energies Nouvelles is a market leader in renewable energies. With a development focused on wind energy for several years and more recently on solar photovoltaic, now a second priority avenue of development, the Group is also present in other segments of the renewable energies market: small hydro, biomass, biofuel and biogas. In addition, the Group is expanding its presence in the distributed renewable energies sector in partnership with EDF.
