It developed for SNCF an eco-uniform, human and environment-friendly: use of fair-trade cotton, measurement of carbon footprint of each clothing of the collection and even recycling of old uniforms.

We'll be widening the strong focus on sustainable development in our "image clothing" business with a view to pursuing Group-wide policy rollout."
