The Banque Populaire Group is strengthening the security of its online banking service with a XIRING strong authentication solution

Paris, 26 January 2009: The Banque Populaire Group is strengthening the security of its online banking operations in order to anticipate the risk of fraud and to develop new added-value services by equipping 400,000 customers with a bank card-based strong authentication solution. XIRING has supplied the Vericodes, which will be deployed to its customer base.

This solution will enable clients of the Banque Populaire Group to carry out their remote transactions in total confidence.

The operating mode is simple: to manage an online banking transaction, users insert their bank card into the reader, type in their PIN on the Vericode keypad, to be validated by the card chip that generates an 8 digit one-time password displayed on the reader LCD. The user then types in the one-time passnumber on the bank Web form to confirm the transaction.

With a bank card-based, personal, strong authentication solution, Internet shopping will follow the same operating mode as that used when making purchases in a local store. To carry out a remote transaction, the Vericode uses the security features provided by the smart card, in addition to the information stored in the chip on the smart card (number, expiry date and security number on the back of the card).

In the UK, this solution is known as Home Chip and Pin. XIRING has already equipped more than 4 million Britons, among the 5 million and more users equipped with such a card reader.

"The security of our clients' banking transactions is one of our major concerns, and as such, we have decided to implement this strong authentication solution which has already met with great success in Europe." commented Bernard Gouraud, Technology Director at the Banque Populaire Group.

"Today, nearly 20 million users are equipped with strong authentication solutions in Europe. We are particularly happy to announce this, the Banque Populaire Group's first launch of this equipment. It heralds the arrival of the Vericode in France, which will benefit both consumers and the banking system. Easy to use and acclaimed by consumers throughout Europe, the Vericode allows users to carry out online banking operations and e-commerce payments in complete security." commented Georges Liberman, CEO of XIRING.
