EDF Energies Nouvelles commissions its Shiloh II wind farm in California (150 MW)

EDF Energies Nouvelles declared commercial operation of the Shiloh II wind farm, one of its most impressive projects to date in the United States, located in California. With 150 MW in capacity, this new facility further strengthens EDF Energies Nouvelles' positions in the US market.

Located in Solano County, California, the Shiloh II wind farm comprises 75 REpower turbines, each with 2 MW in capacity. The power will be sold under a 20-year power purchase agreement to Pacific Gas & Electric, a US electricity company.

During the construction phase, enXco, the US subsidiary of EDF Energies Nouvelles, secured a project financing agreement with Nord LB, in partnership with CIC, Dexia and Société Générale, as well as an agreement with a group of investors led by JP Morgan, together with Wells Fargo and New York Life, which now holds a minority interest in the wind farm.

Commenting on the commissioning of the project, David Corchia said: "Our US teams can be proud of their accomplishment: developing new projects in California is highly challenging and requires a long term local relationship and a high level of development expertise. The financing of the Shiloh II facility, which was arranged in challenging financial conditions, evidences the quality and low-risk profile of the projects developed by EDF Energies Nouvelles."
