EDF Energies Nouvelles announces new agreement to purchase turbines for operations in North America

EDF Energies Nouvelles announces it has reached an agreement with SkyPower Corp., a Canadian renewable energy developer, to purchase the rights to 180 GE turbines for delivery in 2009, presenting a total of 270 MW.

This agreement allows EDF Energies Nouvelles to take the opportunity to acquire equipments under favorable terms. The Group continues to align its supplies with its goals to build wind projects across the US and Canada over the next two or three years.

“Our development is backed by a solid project pipeline. Purchase of these turbines, through the acquisition of a GE agreement under favorable terms, will help us secure our turbine requirements for projects developed in North America for our own account as well as for third parties in 2009, 2010 and 2011,” said David Corchia, CEO of EDF Energies Nouvelles.

The new capacity of 270 MW adds to the 1,369 MW already secured at 31 December 2008 for Europe and North America.
