EDF Energies Nouvelles and Greentech establish a strategic partnership

EDF Energies Nouvelles today announces it has signed an agreement with Greentech Energy Systems A/S, a European developer of wind energy projects to acquire a 50% stake in the Italian 98.9MW Monte Grighine wind project and establish a long-term partnership. The total purchase consideration amounts to €63 million.

EDF EN acquires 50% of Greentech's Monte Grighine wind energy project in Sardinia, which will be Italy's largest wind farm, totalizing 43 Nordex wind turbines for a total installed capacity of 98.9 MW. This wind farm is under construction and the commissioning is expected to take place by the end of the year. Under the agreement signed, Greentech shall bear the cost to complete the project. A portion of the purchase consideration shall be directly allocated to the Project to provide the estimated necessary funds to meet the remaining construction costs.

The partnership agreement also gives EDF EN an option to take a 50% equity stake in every project from Greentech's pipeline in Italy and Poland, which represents approximately 850 MWs. It also applies to all other projects that will be developed by Greentech and reach the "ready to build" stage by year-end 2012.

"This transaction opens the door to a fruitful and successful relationship. Greentech not only has a portfolio of high quality projects, but also comprises a very professional and open-minded team. This transaction shall enable Greentech to complete the construction of the flagship Monte Grighine project. It is for us an excellent opportunity to strengthen our position in Italy and accelerate our development," said David Corchia, Chief Executive Officer of EDF Energies Nouvelles.

"We look forward to cooperating with such a powerful and well positioned partner as EDF EN. This partnership will enable us to continue our growth in the renewable energy sector with the backing of one of the largest players in this field" said Kaj Larsen, Chief Executive Officer of Greentech.

This operation fits with EDF EN's announced strategy of selective acquisitions. It allows EDF EN to strengthen its strong position in Italy and position itself in the promising market of Poland.

Greentech is an energy company developing, constructing and operating wind energy projects. The company is headquartered and domiciled in Greater Copenhagen in Denmark. Greentech has operations in Denmark, Germany, Italy, Norway and Poland. At the moment Greentech owns fully or as a majority partner an installed production capacity of 75 MW, 171.2 MW is under construction, 896.7 MW is in the development portfolio and 220 MW is in the screening process.
