# EDF Energies Nouvelles commissions the Sauveterre wind farm in France

EDF Energies Nouvelles announced the commissioning of a 12 MW wind farm in the south of France, increasing to 23.5 MW the capacity commissioned by the Group in France since the beginning of the year. In northern France, the Fiennes wind farm was put into operation during the first quarter.

The new Sauveterre wind farm is located in the Tarn department. With 12 MW in installed capacity, it comprises six 2 MW turbines supplied by the Danish manufacturer Vestas.

The commissioning of this new facility follows the entry into service in March 2009 of the Fiennes wind farm in the Pas de Calais department. The latter comprises five turbines with a total installed capacity of 11.5 MW, supplied by German manufacturer Enercon.

To date, EDF Energies Nouvelles has commissioned 371.1 MW in gross capacity in France, including 84.2 MW from the DSSA<sup>1</sup> business.
