EDF Energies Nouvelles commissions the Minervino wind farm in Italy

Within the framework of its business expansion in Europe, EDF Energies Nouvelles announced the commissioning of a 32 MW wind farm in southern Italy.

The Minervino wind farm is located in the Bari province of the Apulia region. With installed capacity of 32 MW, it comprises sixteen turbines supplied by German manufacturer REpower.

The facility is held jointly by EDF EN Italia, a 95%-owned subsidiary of EDF Energies Nouvelles, and by Fri-El Green Power, a local partner.

The Minervino wind farm is the fifth Italian project completed by EDF Energies Nouvelles in the wind energy segment and the second in Apulia.

To date, EDF Energies Nouvelles has commissioned 266.1 MW in gross capacity in Italy, 126.4 MW of which is held for its own account.
