Phase 1 of the C-Power offshore wind farm in Belgium commissioned

EDF Energies Nouvelles announced the commissioning of the first 30 MW tranche of the Thorntonbank offshore wind farm developed in Belgium within the C-Power consortium. Eventually, this project, which just reached a key milestone, is set to be one of Europe's largest offshore wind farms.



As part of this first pilot 30 MW phase, six high-power wind turbines (5 MW each) have been installed off the coast of Zeebrugge on the Thorntonbank sand bank.

First offshore project built in Belgium, it will consist – when fully completed – of around sixty wind turbines with a total installed capacity of 300 MW, equivalent to the yearly electricity consumption of a city of 600,000 inhabitants. The power generated will save the emission of about 450,000 tons of CO_2 per year. Construction of the entire wind farm, which is structured in several phases, is expected to be completed in 2013.

EDF Energies Nouvelles holds an equity interest of 18.3% in this project owned by a group of companies, brought together in the Belgian C-Power consortium.

Through its participation to this project, EDF Energies Nouvelles has developed a strong expertise and experience in the construction of offshore wind farms that will be essential in the development of this segment in Europe.
