Information about EDF Energies Nouvelles' interest in the Silicium de Provence project

Silicium de Provence (SilPro) entered court-ordered liquidation on the 4th of August 2009. EDF Energies Nouvelles owns a minority interest in SilPro alongside Sol-Holding, the project's initiator and majority shareholder of the capital.

SilPro, whose aim was to build and operate a plant producing refined silicon for the solar photovoltaic industry, had been placed under administration on the 7th of April as a result of significant funding problems¹.
