EDF Energies Nouvelles signs a turbine agreement with Repower in the United States

As part of its development in North America, EDF Energies Nouvelles announces the signing of an agreement with turbine supplier REpower to deliver up to 143.5 MW.

The turbines are intended to cover the needs of a project developed in the US west coast by enXco, the US subsidiary of EDF Energies Nouvelles. These turbines, with a unit capacity of 2.05 MW, are slated for delivery in 2011. This order is subject to certain condition precedents related to the project.

This agreement highlights continuous momentum of EDF Energies Nouvelles' activities in the United States and the strong relationship established with Repower in North America as well as in Europe.
