## **EDF Energies Nouvelles commissions an 18 MW wind farm in Greece**

**EDF Energies Nouvelles continues its wind energy expansion in Europe and announces the commissioning of the 18 MW Skopies wind farm in Greece.**

Located in Beotia, in the North West of Athens, this wind farm is equipped with six turbines, each of 3 MW, supplied by Danish manufacturer Vestas.

The Skopies facility is 75%-owned by EDF Energies Nouvelles Group through its Greek subsidiary EEN Hellas.

Established in Greece since 2005, EDF Energies Nouvelles became a major wind energy player of the country, and completes here its eighth Greek wind park. To date, EDF EN has commissioned 205.4 MW in gross capacity in the peninsula.
