Air Liquide announces the **acquisition of Cryogas de Centroamerica, S.A.** (Cryogas), a leading supplier of medical and industrial gases in the country of **Panama**. Cryogas is based in Panama City and employs more than 80 people in a number of locations throughout the country.

The agreement to purchase Cryogas' business operations and assets, which include its Air Separation Unit, filling, distribution and retail sales activities, marks **Air Liquide's entry into Panama**, further establishing its presence in the region.

Panama is one of the fastest developing countries in Central America and offers good infrastructure and geographic proximity, a stable business environment and strong growth prospects.
