Offering by Technip of bonds convertible into and/or exchangeable for new or existing shares (OCEANE), due January 1, 2016, for approximately €500 million, which may be increased to approximately €550 million

Granting of the AMF visa

Today, Technip ("Technip" or the "Company") launched an offering of bonds convertible into and/or exchangeable for new or existing shares (OCEANE) due January 1, 2016 (the "Bonds") for approximately €500 million. This amount may be increased up to approximately €550 million if the Joint Lead Managers and Joint Bookrunners exercise in full the 10% over-allotment option on behalf of the Underwriters, which must occur no later than November 15, 2010.

The main purpose of the Bonds issue is to partially refinance a €650 million bond that matures in May 2011, as well as to secure long term financing to cover the group's recent investments.

The par value of the Bonds has been set at €83.10, including an issue premium of 32% over Technip's share reference price on Euronext Paris¹ of €62.95. The Bonds will bear interest at an annual rate of 0.5% payable annually in arrears on January 31 of each year (or on the following business day if that date is not a business day), i.e., €0.42 per year and per Bond. The first coupon payment on January 31, 2011 will amount to €0.09 per Bond. The issue date and the settlement and delivery date of the Bonds is expected to be November 17, 2010. The Bonds will be redeemed at par on January 1, 2016. The Bonds will be convertible into or exchangeable for new and/or existing Technip shares, at the ratio of one share per Bond, subject to possible future anti-dilution adjustments. The Bonds may be redeemed early at Technip's option under certain conditions.

The *Autorité des marchés financiers* (the "AMF") granted visa No. 10-392 dated November 9, 2010 on the prospectus. The subscription period in France shall be open from November 10, 2010 to November 12, 2010.

This offering is led by Banco Santander, BNP Paribas, Crédit Agricole CIB, Deutsche Bank, HSBC and Société Générale, Joint Lead Managers and Joint Bookrunners. ABG Sundal Collier, Banca IMI, BBVA, Citi, CM-CIC Securities and RBS are acting as Co-Lead Managers.

¹ The reference price equals the volume-weighted average price of Technip's shares on Euronext Paris from the opening of trading on November 9, 2010 until the final terms of the Bonds were determined.
