LAFARGE SELLS ITS AGGREGATES & CONCRETE ASSETS IN PORTUGAL, ALSACE (FRANCE) AND SWITZERLAND FOR €120 MILLION

Lafarge announces two disposals totaling circa €120 million, as part of its 2010 divestment plan.

The Aggregates & Concrete business in Portugal

Lafarge has disposed of the integrality of its Aggregates & Concrete business in Portugal (29 concrete plants and 4 aggregates quarries) to the Portuguese construction group Secil. This transaction is subject to approval by the Portuguese competition authorities.

The Aggregates & Concrete businesses in Alsace (East of France) and Switzerland

Lafarge has sold its Aggregates & Concrete business in Alsace and Switzerland, including 8 concrete production plants (4 in Alsace and 4 in Switzerland) and 8 aggregates quarries in Alsace. The Swiss-based concrete operations have been sold to Holcim Switzerland and the French-based A&C activities have been sold to Eiffage Travaux Publics and Holcim France. This disposal will become effective on December 31, 2010.

These transactions are part of the Group's divestment plan, exceeding the target of €500 million of divestments over the year.
