Started in 2009, this program had been suspended during 2010, and its resumption from the month of April 2011 was officially announced in late February.

The Secure Terminal Xi-Plus 5 from XIRING is marketed in Germany by partners who embed their own software solutions. Certified by Gematik and the BSI, this highly secure solution (CC-EAL3+) meets the mobility requirements of German doctors and thus positions XIRING as a major player in this market.
