<p>Disruption of European Production</p>

As a result of the earthquake in Japan last 11 March, part of PSA Peugeot Citroën's diesel engine production will be impacted beginning 23 March, following the interruption of production at an electronic components supplier with a plant in the disaster zone.

The supplier's teams are currently working hard to gradually resume production within a week.

In the meantime, PSA Peugeot Citroën's manufacturing organisation will be adjusted to optimise output and effectively serve the needs of dealers and customers. The European assembly plants partly impacted by the disruption will adjust their output accordingly and introduce appropriate work schedules within a week.

The Works Councils of the plants concerned will begin meeting as of Tuesday 22nd March.
