Europear launches a bond issuance of €125 million to support its acquisition program

Europear Groupe S.A. ("Europear"), a *société anonyme* organized under the laws of France, announced today the launch of a bond issuance of €125 million notes, which will be fully fungible with the 5.750% notes due 2022 issued in June 2015, increasing the total principal amount of this bond to €600 million.

The net proceeds from the issuance of the notes will be used primarily to fund our acquisition program focused on bolt-ons, franchisees and new mobility services, as well as for our general corporate purposes.
