Four more Dreamliners will join the fleet in the following years. By 2018, Oman Air's total fleet size is expected to be around 57 aircraft, rising to 70 aircraft by 2020. Oman Air's outstanding aircraft interiors include its First Class Mini Suite, which provides each of the six First Class passengers with direct aisle access and converts to the longest lie-flat seat in the skies. The A330's outstanding Business Class seats each provide direct aisle access, ample storage space and the latest technological amenities. State of the art in-flight entertainment systems feature individual seatback screens, audio and video on demand and live satellite TV.
