Carmila releases its 2017 interim dividend payment date

Subject to the prior approval of the Shareholders' General Meeting to be convened on November 27, 2017, Carmilla will pay on **November 30, 2017** a 2017 interim dividend equal to **0.75 euro per share**, by way of an exceptional distribution from the "Additional paid-in capital" account

This distribution is the first brick of the Carmila 2017 dividend policy announced earlier this year.

The detachment of the coupon would be effective on November 28, 2017 à 0:00 am.
