## ESG Factors: Total once again selected in 2020 in the Dow Jones Sustainability Indices

**Paris, 30 November 2020** – S&P Dow Jones Indices has announced, on 13 November 2020, the <u>2020 results for the Dow Jones Sustainability Indices</u> (DJSI) which assess companies on ESG (Environment – Social - Governance) criteria.

Total was once again selected as a member of the DJSI World and DJSI Europe indices:

- Total has continuously been a member of the DJSI World index since 2004 (hence for the 17<sup>th</sup> consecutive year now). In 2020, in the Oil & Gas Upstream & Integrated sector, only 7 companies out of an initial universe of 59 companies have been selected. Total is the only major in this index.
- Total has been continuously included in the regional DJSI Europe index since 2005 (except in 2015). In 2020, in the Oil & Gas Upstream & Integrated sector, only 2 companies out of an initial universe of 10 companies have been selected.
