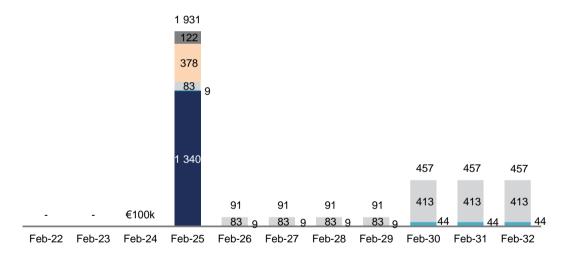
Approval of the amendment to Rallye's safeguard plan relating to the global tender offer launched by Rallye on its unsecured debt and announcement of the settlement date

Paris, May 9, 2022 – Rallye announces that the Paris Commercial Court has approved today the amendment to its safeguard plan, allowing therefore the effective completion of the global tender offer on its unsecured debt launched on March 23, 2022 (the "**Tender Offer**") (see Rallye's press release dated March 23, 2022).

Consequently, the settlement of the Tender Offer will occur on May 16, 2022.

Rallye will spend EUR 36.6 million of cash to acquire EUR 242.3 million of nominal amount of unsecured debt, reducing the total amount of its net financial debt by approximately EUR 234.8 million (including accrued interests). The total amount of unsecured debt purchased under the Tender Offer is allocated between the various instruments according to the breakdown set out in the annex to the press release issued by Rallye on April 6, 2022.

Following the settlement of the Tender Offer, the repayment profile of Rallye's financial debt will be as follows:



- New Money instrument (Tender offers 2021 and 2022)
- Fimalac facility
- Unsecured claims
- Claims secured by pledges over shares of Rallye subsidiaries (other than Casino)
- Claims secured by pledges over Casino shares

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
