# Royal DSM selects Alcatel-Lucent's managed IP solution to transform global voice network

Paris, October 21, 2008 — Alcatel-Lucent (Euronext Paris and NYSE: ALU) today announced it has signed a four-year contract with Royal DSM N.V., based in the Netherlands, to overhaul the Life Sciences and Materials Sciences company's global voice communications infrastructure. Alcatel-Lucent will enable DSM to create an economical, secure, high-speed IP network with a common look and feel for DSM facilities in Europe, Asia and North and South America.

DSM's new China campus in Shanghai, which comprises all Shanghai offices of DSM (China) Ltd. Holdings and several business groups and the R&D labs of DSM in China, has already been upgraded with Alcatel-Lucent's voice network solution. In its design and execution, the DSM China Campus will aim to achieve 'Gold' certification within the LEED program. LEED stands for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design. The DSM China Campus will be one of the first buildings in China to earn the 'Gold' certification within the LEED program.

"We looked for a global and innovative partner as we embarked on a new global IP network for our sites and employees and we found that spirit with Alcatel-Lucent," said Feike Sijbesma and Rolf-Dieter Schwalb, CEO and CFO of DSM. The IP-based solution will reduce the cost of DSM's interoffice phone calls, but will also result in other benefits. When communication is faster and more efficient - information reaching people when, where and how they need it - employee productivity, relationships with vendors and partners, and customer satisfaction all improves.
