

Filing and availability of information documents for the combined shareholders' meeting / Annual Report 2008

Paris, April 1, 2009 - The combined shareholders' meeting of Alcatel-Lucent (Euronext Paris and NYSE: ALU) will be held on Friday, May 29, 2009 at 2:30PM at the Palais des Congrès, 2 Place Porte Maillot in Paris, France.

Information concerning this meeting was published in the official French journal of mandatory legal notices (BALO) on March 27, 2009 and includes the agenda, resolutions and information on how to participate and vote at this meeting.

Alcatel Lucent's French 2008 annual report (Document de référence) and its 2008 annual report on Form 20-F were filed on March 31, 2009 with the *Autorité des marchés financiers* (AMF) and the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) respectively.
