Berlitz English Mobile is a complete application, available in five languages, to learn or relearn English in a fun way. *Berlitz English for Windows Phone 7* features the usual vocabulary, many idiomatic expressions and about a hundred exercises covering ten topics: *Business, Culture, Everyday Life, Sports,* etc.





With the French **Highway Traffic Code** available on your cell phone equipped with Windows Phone 7, everyone can learn or review their lessons anytime, including while on the go.





These three applications: SendPhotos Mobile, Berlitz English and Highway Traffic Code for Windows Phone 7 will be unveiled for the first time as part of the award ceremony for the *Pitch Your App* Prize to be awarded by Steve Ballmer on October 7, 2010.
