## **DANONE PUBLISHES ITS REGISTRATION DOCUMENT 2010**

DANONE has filed its Registration Document 2010 ('Document de Référence 2010') with the French Financial Markets Authority ('Autorité des Marchés Financiers') on March 25<sup>th</sup> 2011.

- the information related to the fees paid to the statutory auditors; and
- the description of the share buyback program.
