OSIATIS ACQUIRES APPLICATION DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES IN FRANCE OF BT GLOBAL SERVICES, A DIVISION OF BT GROUP PLC

Osiatis, a leading French IT services company, confirms its positioning on New Technology Development, particularly in infrastructure associated applications, and announces the acquisition of application development business goodwill in France of BT Global Services, a division of BT Group PLC.
