
EDF extends a series of existing agreements with Chinese energy actors

Upon the visit of President Xi Jinping in France, EDF has signed a series of agreements in thermal and nuclear energies with its Chinese partners.

EDF and China Datang Corporation sign a thermal cooperation agreement

EDF and the Chinese electricity producer China Datang Corporation (CDT) have signed an agreement whereby the two groups renew their willingness to identify joint thermal power projects in China and internationally, following the agreement of April 2013.

EDF strengthens its partnerships with CGN and CNNC in nuclear energy

EDF and China General Nuclear Corporation (CGN) have signed a global partnership agreement in the nuclear field.

This agreement renews the agreement signed back in 2010 and states that, as operators of the world's two most extensive fleets of nuclear power plants, EDF and CGN are set to continue their cooperation across all their respective areas of expertise (operation and maintenance, engineering, research & development) with the common aim of guaranteeing the highest possible safety standards.

The two companies have also signed a protocol to foster industrial cooperation between EDF and its Chinese partners on the British nuclear market.

As for EDF and CNNC, they have agreed to reinforce their cooperation in nuclear energy, especially regarding engineering, operation and maintenance.

EDF Group, one of the leaders in the European energy market, is an integrated energy company active in all areas of the business: generation, transmission, distribution, energy supply and trading. The Group is the leading electricity producer in Europe. In France, it has mainly nuclear and hydropower generation facilities where 95.9% of the electricity output is CO₂-free. EDF's transmission and distribution subsidiaries in France operate 1,285,000 km of low and medium voltage overhead and underground electricity lines and around 100,000 km of high and very high voltage networks. The Group is involved in supplying energy and services to approximately 28.5 million customers in France. The Group generated consolidated sales of €75.6 billion in 2013, of which 46.8% outside of France. EDF is listed on the Paris Stock Exchange and is a member of the CAC 40 index.
