Paris, France - 31 October 2014 - Shared Services Connected Limited (SSCL) has been awarded a contract to provide a range of corporate shared services to the UK's Ministry of Justice and Home Office. The contract will take effect from 31 October 2014.

SSCL is a joint venture between the UK's Cabinet Office and Steria and provides finance, procurement and HR services, creating a more cost effective Civil Service by eliminating duplication and maximising the benefits of standardised systems.

This contract also marks a key milestone in the expected expansion of SSCL which was established in November 2013 to achieve greater value for money by consolidating existing service centres for the Department of Work and Pensions, Defra, the Environment Agency and UK SBS.
