FAIVELEY TRANSPORT CONFIRMS IT HAS BEEN AWARDED THE CONTRACT TO MODERNISE AND UPGRADE 202 COACHES IN ALGERIA

The railway equipment manufacturers consortium Faiveley Transport and Compin SAS confirm that it has been awarded the contract for the modernisation and upgrade of 202 main-line and suburban passenger coaches by Algeria's national rail company, *Société Nationale des Transports Ferroviaires* (SNTF).

This contract, worth more than €75 million, including more than €45 million for Faiveley Transport as leader of the consortium, had been provisionally awarded in January 2014. Lasting 48 months, it involves the study, manufacture and delivery of all equipments required for the coaches' upgrade.

Faiveley Transport will supply its entire range of equipment, including new doors, heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems, passenger information systems and the parts needed for the overhaul of the braking systems, as well as all the components allowing their integration in the coaches. Compin will carry out the full interior fit-out.

This contract is one of the SNTF's projects to modernise, upgrade and refurbish its main-line and suburban coaches. It complements the order, recently secured by Faiveley Transport Group, for HVAC (heating, ventilation and air conditioning) systems and power converters for 36 main-line passenger coaches.

It will be managed by Faiveley Transport's French sites of Saint Pierre des Corps, La Ville aux Dames, Neuville en Ferrain and Amiens, and by Evreux' site of Compin.

Jérôme Spencer, President of Faiveley Transport's Services Division said, "These contracts confirm the trust that the Société Nationale des Transports Ferroviaires (SNTF) puts in Faiveley Transport Group in its role as partner for the supply of equipment and related long-term maintenance."
