Pursuant to Article 222-1 of the General Regulations of the Autorité des marchés financiers (AMF), RCI Banque SA with headquarters located in France said its Home Member State for the purpose of Directive 2004 / 109 / EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 December 2004 (the Transparency Directive), is France. As a consequence, the national competent authority to monitor the compliance of its obligations disclosing regulated information is the AMF .
