FAIVELEY TRANSPORT TO SUPPLY HVAC AND BRAKING SYSTEMS FOR THE FUTURE MP14 PARIS METRO

Faiveley Transport has been awarded contracts by Alstom to supply HVAC (heating, ventilation and refrigerated ventilation) and braking systems for the new MP14 Paris metro trains to be built for the STIF (Syndicat des transports d'Île de France), the SGP (Société du Grand Paris) and the RATP (Régie Autonome des Transports Parisiens). The contracts for the first 35 MP14 trains, each comprised of 8 cars, amount to nearly € 15 million with up to 217 trains to be delivered over a period of 15 years.

The contracts awarded to Faiveley Transport involve low noise and energy efficient compact saloon HVAC systems (heating, ventilation and refrigerated ventilation) and braking systems (brake control and bogie brakes). They both include the study, design, manufacture and delivery of the equipment. The HVAC contract will be performed by new Faiveley Transport's site in Plzeň, Czech Republic, with deliveries starting between late 2016 and mid 2021. The braking systems contract will be managed by Faiveley Transport sites in Amiens, France, and Landskrona, Sweden, with delivery expected to start by mid 2016 and to be completed by 2021.

MP14 is Alstom's seventh and latest generation rubber-tyred train used on the Paris metro, featuring low energy consumption, high performance and ease of maintenance. The first 35 MP14 eight-car trains will be deployed to the initial extension of line 14 between the Saint Lazare and Mairie de Saint-Ouen stations, whilst additional MP14 trains are expected to operate on lines 1, 4, 6, 11 and 14 (second phase of the extension project) of the Paris Metro and the Grand Paris Project.
