The NORBERT DENTRESSANGLE and SNCF Groups have reached an agreement on the disposal of the stake held by the NORBERT DENTRESSANGLE Group in the capital of NOVATRANS (43,549 shares, or 15.1% of the capital) to the benefit of SNCF's Transport and Logistics Division (through its TLP Company).

This disposal has been submitted for approval to the French competition authorities.
