The reason for the company not filing by March 1, 2011 relates to the identification of a material weakness in internal control over financial reporting for income taxes and the amount of time required to perform additional testing on, and reconciliation of, the tax accounts. As a result of identification of this material weakness and the results of additional testing, we have notified shareholders that they should not rely on our previously issued financial reports for the relevant periods.
