FDL continues its growth in Berlin with the acquisition of 685 residential units for €54 million

After an initial acquisition of 958 residential units last April, Foncière Développement Logements (FDL) continued its growth in Berlin by signing a new agreement protocol for the acquisition of 716 lots, including 685 residential units representing a total of 50,296 m². Concluded at a price of €54 million, including costs and taxes, this deal yields an average price, excluding costs and taxes, of €994/m².

Rental potential and good liquidity upon resale

This asset portfolio generates gross rental income of €3.9 million, i.e., a return on investment (excluding costs and taxes) of 7.8%. Located primarily in the Mitte quarter, these units have significant leasing potential and very good liquidity at resale.

Half the acquisition will be financed by shareholders' equity and half by a bank loan through one or more German banks.

Pursuing geographic diversity

Through its German subsidiary Immeo Wohnen, Foncière Développement Logements is now entering a new phase in its strategy of geographic diversification of its assets in Germany.

After completing these two deals by 1 August 2011, FDL will hold 1,643 residential units, i.e., approximately 5% of its total assets by value in the German capital.

Outlook

The two acquisitions in Berlin, generating high returns and creating value, will contribute to fuelling the company's income growth in 2011.
