## TF1 SIGNS A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH SONY PICTURES TELEVISION DISTRIBUTION

TF1 and Sony Pictures Television Distribution have signed a partnership agreement on the TV series, film catalogue and TV films of the Studio with a view to broadcasting them on all the channels of the TF1 Group. The agreement also covers rights for new distribution media.

In terms of cinema, we will be enhancing TF1 programming with major productions, including Salt and, soon, The Amazing Spider-Man and Tintin."

We have a very strong television slate to offer TF1 schedulers, including several high profile network series such as *Charlie's Angels*.
