# Siraga records a 17% increase in turnover for the 2011-2012 financial year

As expected, the Group's annual turnover has increased 17% compared with the 2010 – 2011 financial year, to €37,825,000\*.

### Extremely dynamic engineering activity

Engineering activity continued to increase. Over this financial year, the Group won several major engineering contracts and prospects look very good for the coming months.

The Belgian subsidiary, Siraga Engineering, is celebrating its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year and plans to continue to increase this activity, mainly by diversifying the types of turnkey LPG projects in Africa and the Middle East.

### Continued modernisation of filling plants in South America

Filling plants in South America have continued to invest in modernising the gas cylinder distribution system. Siraga was successful thanks to the Hydraulis palletiser, its highly innovative palletizing system adapted to client requirements.

### Siraga extends its range of Distri'Gas products

Since early 2012, Siraga has been marketing three automatic gas cylinder vending machines, each with a capacity appropriate to its place of distribution: one for service stations, one for supermarkets and the other for hypermarkets. Siraga is therefore in a position to offer different solutions which allow it to supply all gas cylinder distribution channels.

Furthermore, these distributors are part of the increasingly frequent reorganisation of service stations, which are becoming fully automated.
