These New Debentures were issued in addition to the \$801,649,000 aggregate principal amount of New Debentures issued on August 15, 2012 pursuant to the Exchange Offers. The New Debentures were issued in reliance on exemptions from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933, as amended.
