

Caterpillar Inc. Files Form 8-K

PEORIA, Ill., May 17, 2013 -- Caterpillar Inc. (NYSE: CAT / NYSE Euronext: CATR / LSE: CTA) announced today, a Form 8-K has been filed with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") with respect to the resolution of all outstanding issues between Caterpillar Inc. and Mining Machinery Limited arising out of Caterpillar's acquisition of ERA, including its wholly-owned subsidiary Zhengzhou Siwei Mechanical & Electrical Co., Ltd., commonly known as "Siwei."

Caterpillar files electronically with the SEC required reports on Form 8-K, Form 10-Q, Form 10-K and Form 11-K; proxy materials; ownership reports for insiders as required by Section 16(a) of the U.S. Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended; and registration statements on Forms S-3 and S-8, as necessary; and other forms or reports, as required.
