Commissioning of new wind farm in Molinons (Yonne department)

After the recent announcement of the commissioning of a new wind power plant in Adriers, Voltalia announces the start of operations at its new 10MW wind power plant in Molinons on December 9, 2014.

The excellent management of the construction process, started in 2013, allowed a commissioning of the farm well within the Q4 deadline (announced in press releases dated May 22, 2013 and April 8, 2014 and repeated at the time of the Euronext IPO in July 2014).

Vestas provided the wind turbines. There are five V100-type machines, with a nominal output power of 2.0 MW each. Engineering and construction of the main infrastructures (civil engineering and electrical engineering) were entrusted to Eiffage Energies and the construction of the main delivery station to Schneider Electric. With a total capacity of 10MW, the wind power plant produces enough electricity -without any greenhouse gas emission- to cover the consumption of 10,000 households.

"As the energy transition is ongoing, I am proud of our partnership with Voltalia and proud that Voltalia chose the village of Molinons to install its wind power plant. Thanks to the economic entailed benefits, this plant will benefit the whole area", says Mayor Yves Bézine, pleased.

Sébastien Clerc, Voltalia's CEO, declares: "I thank the Mayor as well as the whole village for their warm welcome. I am glad to see that we share the same beliefs about the importance of renewable energy to meet tomorrow's needs".

Voltalia's production capacity in France now amounts to 68.4 MW, all energy sources included (wind, solar, hydraulic and biomass), in Metropolitan France as well as French Guiana.

Next on the agenda: Q4 2014 and 2014 full-year revenues to be disclosed on February 27, 2015 post trading.
