Karl L. Holz appointed Member of the Supervisory Board

(Marne-la-Vallée, June 5, 2015) At its meeting held on May 28, 2015, the Supervisory Board of Euro Disney S.C.A. (the “Board”) approved the appointment of Mr. Karl L. Holz as a new Board member, succeeding Mr. Thomas O. Staggs who stepped down from the Board following his promotion to Chief Operating Officer of The Walt Disney Company. This appointment will be submitted for ratification at the next annual shareholders’ meeting of Euro Disney S.C.A.

Mr. Holz began his career with The Walt Disney Company’s Parks & Resorts business segment in 1996 and has held various leadership positions since then, including serving as President and Chief Executive Officer of Euro Disney S.A.S. from 2005-2008. Since 2009, he has been President of New Vacation Operations and Disney Cruise Line for Walt Disney Parks and Resorts Worldwide.
