Cergy-Pontoise, April 13, 2022 - *SPIE SA announces the publication of its 2021 Universal Registration Document (URD), including the annual financial report for the 2021 fiscal year, registered by the French securities regulator, the Autorité des marchés financiers (AMF) on April 12, 2022 under the number D.22-0279.*
