APRR's consolidated revenue excluding Construction amounted to €1,454.1 million in the first half of 2023, compared with €1,348.3 million in the first half of 2022, an increase of 7.8%.

Toll revenues from Aliaé (A79), which entered service on 4 November 2022, amounted to €16.5 million.

Overall traffic increased by 3.0% in the 1st semester of 2023 compared to the previous year.

Light vehicle traffic was up 3.5% over the semester, while heavy goods vehicle traffic increased by 1.0%.

APRR's consolidated net sales excluding Construction amounted to €759.0 million in the second quarter of 2023, compared with €695.3 million in the second quarter of 2022, an increase of 9.2%.

Toll revenues from Aliaé (A79), which entered service on 4 November 2022, amounted to €8.6 million.

Total traffic rose by 4.2% in the 2nd quarter of 2023 compared with the previous year.

Light vehicle traffic grew by 4.9% over the quarter, while heavy goods vehicle traffic increased by 0.5%.

### **Significant events**

On 11 May 2023, APRR successfully placed a new €0.7 billion bond issue maturing in January 2030 for a coupon of 3.125%.
