EDF Strengthens its Position in Renewable Energies by Acquiring 66.5% of SUPRA

EDF accelerates its involvement with renewable energies involving no CO₂ emissions by acquiring - through its subsidiary EDEV EnR Réparties - 66.5% of SUPRA for EUR 31.97 per share. Wood, the leading renewable domestic energy source, will enable EDF to strengthen its position in the field of renewable energy, complementing solar and photovoltaic power (direct and indirect stakes in Tenesol and Giordano).

SUPRA manufactures fireplaces and woodburning stoves, and markets and sells HVAC units for heating and air treatment for individual homes under brand names including Supra and Richard Le Droff.

The acquisition of SUPRA by EDEV EnR Réparties is part of EDF's strategy to grow its presence in renewable energies for the home. It will also allow EDF to keep its commitments to acquire energy savings certificates.

A tender offer for the shares owned by minority shareholders will be filed with the AMF pursuant to applicable laws and regulations. In the meantime, trading in SUPRA shares will remain suspended.

About SUPRA

SUPRA specializes in the design, manufacture, and sale of wood-burning heating products intended for individual homes. A pioneer of enclosed heating units for wood-burning fireplaces, Supra developed a range of heating devices using the latest technology, combining comfort and well-being, while protecting our natural environment for the future. Among the leaders in its market, the company sells fireplaces, heating units, furnaces, and boilers and has developed a business in trading specialized heating devices and air conditioners. It makes and sells its products under the brand names Supra and Richard Le Droff. Production is located at two facilities in Obernai (Alsace) and Auneau (Eure-et-Loir). It does business in 25 countries worldwide. In 2006, it had sales of € 73 million and is showing strong growth from 2005, since the market for renewable energy sources, especially wood, is showing strong growth. Supra is traded on the Paris Stock Exchange, Compartiment C of the Eurolist of Euronext™.

About EDF

EDF Group, a leader in the European energy market, is a vertically integrated energy company operating in all business lines in the energy business from generation to transmission, distribution and the buying and selling of energy in its various forms. As Europe's largest electricity producer, the Group's power generating capacity in France consists mainly of nuclear and hydropower plants generating electricity which is 95% CO₂ emission-free. EDF manages over 1,200,000 km of overhead and underground and medium and lower voltage power lines and approximately 100 000 km of high and extra high voltage lines.
