At maturity, the Noteholders are entitled to receive at least the amount initially invested on the Issue Date (the « Minimum Redemption Amount »). The actual redemption date of these Notes is directly related to the performance of the Underlying(s): the better the performance, the sooner the redemption date and conversely, the worse the performance and the later the redemption date. The return under these Notes is totally linked to the performance of the Underlying(s): the higher the performance, the higher the return. The return depends upon the fact that the performance of the Underlying(s) reaches or does not reach a pre-determined threshold. Accordingly, a small downward or upward movement of the Underlying(s) close to the threshold may result in a significantly larger increase or decrease of the return of the Notes.
