## CANÇÃO NOVA TV EXPANDS GLOBALLY WITH SES WORLD SKIES

Brazilian Catholic Foundation delivers faith-based programming worldwide via NSS-806

Washington, DC – March 23, 2011 – Home to Latin America's premier television content, SES WORLD SKIES, a division of SES S.A. (Euronext Paris and Luxembourg Stock Exchange: SESG), today announced a new capacity deal with Brazil's John Paul II Foundation to deliver more Canção Nova TV channels into more regions of the world.

Under the ten-year, multi-million-dollar agreement, Canção Nova TV is using 23 MHz of C-band capacity on SES WORLD SKIES' NSS-806 satellite to distribute Catholic faith-based programming to millions of viewers across Latin America, North America and Europe. Much of Canção Nova TV's entertainment, news and religious content is produced in the town of Cachoeira Paulista in the state of São Paulo, Brazil, where it's uplinked in a variety of languages to cable and satellite system subscribers.

Canção Nova TV content distribution will automatically and seamlessly transition from NSS-806 to SES-6 when the advanced SES-6 spacecraft is launched and commercially available in the coveted 319.5° East orbital slot. Scheduled to launch in 2013, SES-6 will offer enhanced coverage and capacity in North America and Latin America.

"Our long-term agreement represents a powerful alliance with the leading satellite operator and a strategic consolidation of broadcast services onto one satellite, which provides far broader coverage and better cost efficiencies," said Mauricio Belonio, Broadcast Engineering Manager for Canção Nova TV. "SES WORLD SKIES has enabled us to deliver more Canção Nova TV channels to more viewers in far more regions of the world than ever before."

"This strategic alignment with Canção Nova TV reinforces what Latin America's blue chip broadcasters and cable systems have known for years – that SES has the leading video neighborhood in the region," said Dolores Martos, Vice President of Sales in Latin America and the Caribbean for SES WORLD SKIES. "We look forward to putting our global reach to work in support of the mission-critical outreach of the John Paul II Foundation."

The SES-6 satellite, scheduled for launch in 2013, will replace the NSS-806 spacecraft at the core orbital location at 319.5° East and provide a significant capacity expansion. The expanded Ku-band payload of SES-6 will offer substantially enhanced coverage and capacity in North America, Central America and South America.
