
EDF GROUP UPGRADES ITS EBITDA TARGET FOR 2021

In light of the new nuclear output estimate in France for 2021 notably, the Group's EBITDA⁽¹⁾ target for 2021 is upgraded to more than €17.7 billion, versus more than €17 billion previously.
