STMicroelectronics Announces Status of Common Share Repurchase Program

Disclosure of Transactions in Own Shares – Period from Apr 19, 2022 to Apr 22, 2022

AMSTERDAM – April 25, 2022 -- STMicroelectronics N.V. (the "Company" or "STMicroelectronics"), a global semiconductor leader serving customers across the spectrum of electronics applications, announces full details of its common share repurchase program (the "Program") disclosed via a press release dated July 1, 2021. The Program was approved by a shareholder resolution dated May 27, 2021 and by the supervisory board.

STMicroelectronics N.V. (registered with the trade register under number 33194537) (LEI: 213800Z8NOHIKRI42W10) (Ticker: "STM") announces the repurchase (by a broker acting for the Company) on the regulated market of Euronext Paris, in the period between Apr 19, 2022 to Apr 22, 2022 (the "Period"), of 190,739 ordinary shares (equal to 0.02% of its issued share capital) at the weighted average purchase price per share of EUR 35.4090 and for an overall price of EUR 6,753,883.05.

Below is a summary of the repurchase transactions made in the course of the Period in relation to the ordinary shares of STM (ISIN: NL0000226223), in detailed form.

Transactions in Period

Following the share buybacks detailed above, the Company holds in total 7,300,961 treasury shares, which represents approximately 0.8% of the Company's issued share capital.
